

Made to Measure Guide for Blinds (refer to the diagrams)

It is a good idea to measure all windows, to avoid issues with fitting, as window sizes can vary.

Decide on how you would like your blinds to be fitted. Inside the recess or outside the recess.

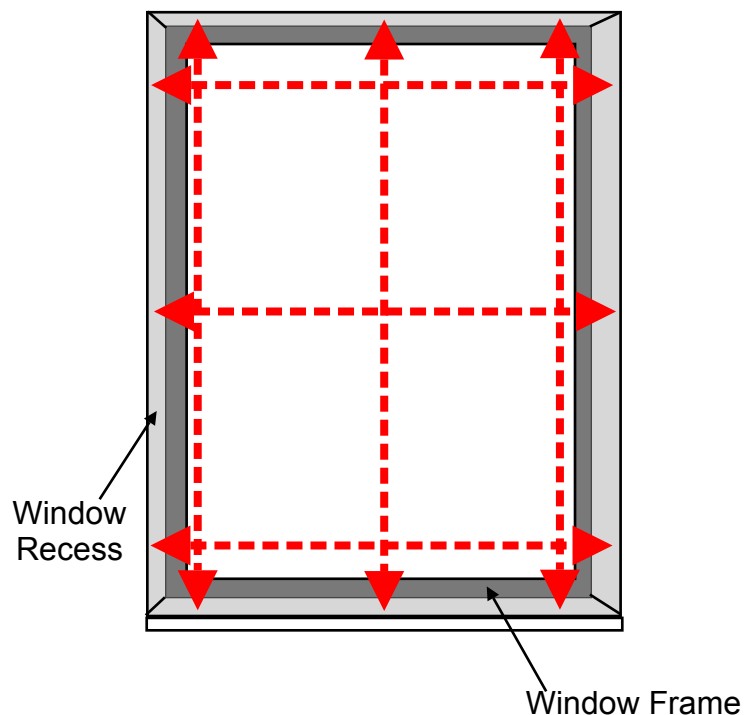
Keep an eye out for handles or tiles. You will need to take their position into account to ensure a perfect fit.

1: INSIDE RECESS.

Measure at 6 points, as indicated in diagram 1. Record the smallest dimension as "Recess size". This will result in the head rail being made narrower in width and the blind type being made shorter in length to allow for a snug fit inside the recess.

Always record your measurements by width x drop and always record every window in the same order.

2: OUTSIDE RECESS (Blind Size)

Measure at 6 points, as indicated in diagram 2. For best results, measure a minimum of 100 mm (10 cm) past the recess on each side (see 'A' on diagram).

Ensure to add a minimum of 100 mm (10 cm) above the recess (see 'B' on diagram). Record the largest dimension as your measurement for Blind Size. This will result in the blind being made to the exact size specified.

Always record your measurements by width x drop and always record every window in the same order.
